

Warming Place opening Friday

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The Warming Place, Nantucket's only shelter for the unhoused, will be opening for our fourth season Friday, Nov. 1. Emergency shelter will be offered seven days per week for those who are in need.

The day shelter offers a warm place to gather, a meal and community resources every Monday and Thursday from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. at the Summer Street Church, located at 1 Summer St. The overnight shelter will be open from 6 p.m. to 7 a.m. and will offer a warm and safe space to sleep, a hot meal and compassion.

The First Congregational Church at 62 Centre St. will host Sunday through Wednesday night, and the Summer Street Church will host Thursday through Saturday night.

Dinner and breakfast will be provided. Individuals who use the shelter must be 18 or older. Check in time is between 6 and 7 p.m.

We ask community members to inform anyone that they know who is experiencing homelessness to come to The Warming Place. They will find a warm space, hot meals and vital connections to medical and mental-health services.
